



## DISTRICT AND STATE TOURNAMENT GAME CONDUCT

---

1. All games will be played under rules and regulations covered in the Babe Ruth League, Inc. Baseball Rules and Regulations and Official Playing Rules.
2. Games will be kept moving at all times. No unnecessary delay or mound conferences, etc. will be permitted.
3. Anyone, including players, coaches and managers acting in an unsportsmanlike manner shall be removed from the playing field or ballpark immediately and could result in disqualification from the tournament.
4. Managers, coaches and players must wear full uniforms according to Babe Ruth League, Inc. rules. While in uniform, neatness is a must.
5. Protective headgear must be worn at bat and on the bases.
6. Equipment- bats, gloves, helmets, etc., shall be stacked neatly in the dugout in their proper places at all times.
7. Only players, coaches, the manager and batboy shall be allowed in the dugouts. Players must stay inside the dugouts.
8. Masks with throat protector will be required at all times when warming up the pitcher, whether on the field or in the bullpen.
9. Tobacco use is not permitted on the playing field, dugout or restroom by a manager, coaches or player of a team while engaged in a regular scheduled game.

### **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS**

1. The District and/or State Commissioner shall have the authority to remove any player, coach or manager for actions detrimental to Babe Ruth League, Inc. Any misbehavior or misconduct on or off the field could cause the disqualification of a manager, coach, player, or of the entire team from the tournament.
2. District tournaments are under the jurisdiction of the District Commissioner. State tournaments are under the jurisdiction of the State Commissioner. Tournament directors may be appointed; however, the tournaments remain under the jurisdiction of the respective Commissioner.
3. The Protest Committee shall have the final authority in all protests.
4. The Protest Committee shall be appointed by the Tournament Director in accordance with Babe Ruth League, Inc. rule 11.05 #9.
